There is good news for those seeking admission to postgraduate courses at government medical colleges in the state. Gujarat will see a record increase, 400-odd, in the number of PG medical seats.

Gujarat currently has 1,500 PG medical seats, of which 1,300 are at Government medical colleges. The state get at least 400 seats more, even with the 30% vacancies in medical teachers.

HC wants state to form SIT for probe into fake accident claims

Ahmedabad,

Staring at massive levels of fraud in accident claims, Gujarat high court said on Tuesday that it expect the state government to constitute a special investigation team (SIT) to probe and curb false claims made in cases of motor accidents.

er Uttar Pradesh's Workman Compensation Commissioner filed a complaint before the state's Bar Council against advocates indulging in the fraud.

The high court said it expected a "positive response from the state government" in forming an SIT. "In fact, constitution of such a team will help in curbing fake claims filed under the Motor Vehicles Act," Justice J B Pardiwala said, while hearing a petition by ICICI Lombard Insurance Company, demanding the for-

matation of an ST to curb fake claims in accident cases. The petitioner's advocate Devang Vyas cited a Supreme court order passed last month, by which issued notices to all state governments, Union Territories, high courts etc. over fake accident claims under the Motor Vehicle ct. The apex court termed the situation of fake claims and the indulgence of advocates in this big fraud "very alarming".

The SC appreciated an initiative of the Allahabad high court to form an SIT to investigate such fake claims. This happened after

AI to receive four Dreamliners by October, 2017: Minister

New Delhi,

The central government on Thursday said national passenger carrier Air India is expected to receive four Boeing 787-8 'Dreamliner' aircraft by October, 2017.

"One B787-8 aircraft will be delivered in July, 2017, two B787-8 aircraft in August, 2017 and the 27th B787-8 aircraft will be delivered in October, 2017," Minister of State for Civil Aviation Jayant Sinha told the Lok Sabha. "Air India has acquired 23 'Dreamliners' progressively from September, 2012 to January 9, 2017," Sinha said in a written reply. However, the Minister observed that, since induction, the Dreamliner aircraft fleet has experienced "technical reliability" issues.
